Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[2]	Navitha is working at the Diya workshop. She pays only 500 for the van and the balance is covered by donations or by Diya.
Details of the beneficiary[3]	Sowmya Dhanalaxmi
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[3]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[3]	Sowmya has been with Diya since it started and is one of their oldest trainees. SHe has been with them for past 7 years. Now in her 30s, she gets a stipend of around 1000 every month. She pays a subsidised fee of 500 for the van and the rest is covered by Diya and donations.
