Payment made at the beginning of the next month as a credit in the bank account. 4 ANCs and 70 rupees per visit. 150 for home delivery. 350 for institutional deliveries. 2 PNC and 70 rupees per visit. The items in the kit are given once in a quarter when they go for trainings. Withdraw money by filling up a slip (showed the bank passbook). Too many coupons to fill up. Coupons are filled up by family members or neighbors who know to write.
