He is intellectually disabled and has been learning welding and fabrication at Naseoh for a year now and receives a stipend of 800 per month. He is not paying anything and the family is very happy that he has got this opportunity.

Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[2]	We met Sumit's mother Sneha at her home which is in slum area. His father has passed away. As per report he is 20 years but his mother said he was 22 years old. He is intellectually disabled. She is very grateful for the opportunity given for her son to learn and is keen for him to start working at a proper job. It was easy to locate their house using google maps. Sumit is learning gardening and has been learning gardening for two years now and receives a stipend of 800 per month.
