Kids enjoy having Idli Sambar in lunch as compared to khichdi. Chikki and bhel should be sent in more quantity. Kids do not carry lunch as they depend on the mid day meals.

Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[2]	Met the principal, the socio economic background of the kids in school is very poor as their parents are domestic workers who step out if their house early morning. The mid day meal is a motivation factor for the kids and parents. Strength of the school kids is 350, they received 6 boxes i.e 8kgs.
