She has been attending the support classes at BNP centre since last 2 years. She is a regular student of the classes and attends every day from 5 to 7 pm. Special classes or activity such as Karate classes are conducted on every Tuesday/Thursday/Saturday. Besides this she has also been taken to excursion at Shinde Chhatri (Amusement park) and Military camp during her vacations through BNP along with her other classmates. She was provided stationery supplies for science projects. All the services are free of cost for her and she is not paying any fees or charges for the support classes.
