Verification Visit status of beneficiary[1]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[1]	Laxmiben and her child was not available during the visit, hence verified the details from father of Laxmiben. The baby girl was born on 1st Jan 2016 delivered at Shree Krishna hospital. The baby was only 800 gm at the time of birth and was kept in Intensive care unit for 70 days. The beneficiary family is migrant labors with very low income of around Rs. 5000/- per month and were not in the condition of paying the hospital huge bills. NGO helped them through various social donation to overcome the total expense of Rs. 2.75 Lac towards hospital bill for the overall treatment out of which the beneficiary family paid Rs. 55000/-.
Details of the beneficiary[2]	Sitaben Satishbhai Talpada
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[2]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[2]	Sitaben was admitted to Shree Krishna Hospital for 4 days from 21/10/2015 to 23/10/2015 for low birth weight for gestational age. She was getting 3 meals a day in the hospital, free of cost. Currently both baby and mother are healthy.
Details of the beneficiary[3]	Jyotiben Ramanbhai Chauhan
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[3]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[3]	Jyotiben was admitted at Shree Krishna Hospital in Sep 2015. Since the delivery done wasa Caesarian, 3 bottles of blood werrerequired during the delivery and it was provided free of cost to the patient. The delivery was complicated but was carried out successfully and a baby girl was delivered on 14/09/2015.
Details of the beneficiary[4]	Shitalben Chhotabhai Talpada

Verification Visit status of beneficiary[4]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[4]	Shitalben had expired 10-12 days before the visit, hence confirmed with one of her relative about the details. She had undergone radiation therapy several times in Feb 2016. The Hospital conducted the therapy free of cost. Besides, the NGO had done all the other treatments of the child on very subsidized rates since the economic condition of the family was very critical.
Details of the beneficiary[5]	Sureshbhai Chokaji Marvadi
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[5]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[5]	Sureshbhai is a driver by profession. His treatment is going on at Shree Krishna hospital under medical supervision of Dr. Nirav Asravad. He has completed 6 chemotherapy sessions conducted in the period Oct 2015 to Feb 2016. All the 6 sessions were free of cost.
Details of the beneficiary[6]	Shardaben Punambhai Panchal

Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[6]	Shardaben is 70 yrs old and She was identified during an eye check up camp organised at Patelwadi in Apr 2015. SHE underwent cataract surgery at Shree Krishna hospital in the month of May 2015 and was admitted for 2 days. She was provided Intraocular lenses, post surgery and all the expenses incurred were free of cost. She hadgonefor follow-up 3-4 times after the surgery for medications and check up.
Details of the beneficiary[7]	Ganibhai Rasulbhai Ghachi
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[7]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[7]	Ganibhai is 70 yrs oldandwas admitted inGeneralWard for treatment of blood circulation issues at Shree Krishna hospital for 7 days. During his stay,he was provided with 3 meals a day,free of cost. The total expense of the hospital was around Rs. 10000/-,out of which Rs. 4200/- incurred for food was excluded from the hospital bill.
Details of the beneficiary[8]	Lakha Vajabhai Thakor

Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[8]	Lakha Vajabhai has undergone all the 33 sessions of radiotherapy at Shree Krishna hospital. The treatment was started in Aug 2015. His cancer has been treated successfully and now living a normal life. All the sessions were done free of cost.
Details of the beneficiary[9]	Bhailabhai Haribhai Thakor
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[9]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[9]	Bhailabhai, 36 yrs,is currently taking cancer treatment from Shree Krishna hospital. He is suffering from oral cavity cancer and has undergone 7 sessions of Chemotherapy from Apr 2015 to July 2015. The therapy was free of cost and the patient is currently continuing his treatment from Himalaya Hospital, Baroda.
Details of the beneficiary[10]	Abdul Kadarbhai Sattarbhai Meman
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[10]	Success

Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[10]	Abdul Kadarbhai has expired in Dec 2015 hence I confirmed the details from his daughter-in-law who was available during the visit. Abdul Kadarbhai had undergone 10 sessions of radiotherapy from Shree Krishna hospital for the period of June 2015 to Dec 2015. The radiotherapy sessions were free of cost.
Details of the beneficiary[11]	Harshadbhai Kantibhai Parmar
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[11]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[11]	Harshadbhai is 25 yrs age and was admitted to Shree Krishna hospital in Aug 2015. He met with a road accident and has lost his left leg. He was admitted for nearly 56 days and got discharged on 21st Oct 2015. He got concession of Rs. 22000 in his hospital bill towards bed charges.
