She has not been regular these past few months due to epileptic fits but will start attending regularly once she is better. She is learning Braille at school which she attends from 11 to 4. She does not pay anything. The family pays a private rickshaw to drop and pick her up.

The school timings are 11 to 4 and he does not pay any fees. When there is an examination or a project, the family may have to pay 20/- or 30/- rupees.
