He is getting 3 meals B/F, Lunch - After school lunch, evening milk and dinner at the centre.

Cook, 4 care givers & 1 care giver for night. The capacity of the centre is of 80 children's and currently there are 55 residential and 20 day care children's of age group from 3 months to 15 years. The centre is divided in Creche - 11 male & 8 female, Montesary - 14 male & 8 female, School going - 10 male & 19 female. Out of 4 care givers 3 are residential and 1 is only for night shift. The Social worker arranges heath camps and deals with advocacy on child rights and other social related issues. Once the child completes 15 years he is referred to boardings or hostels for further care and studies but currently the NGO is planning to expand its services to provide the hostel services as well. Beside this yearly 2 camps are conducted for free medical and dental check ups for the children's.
