Verification Visit status of beneficiary[1]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[1]	Chhotalbai confirmed he had his cataract surgery and he is more comfortable to move around. It was a completely free procedure and also followed up post-op. This has given him a tad bit more independence than previously.
Details of the beneficiary[2]	Mahijibhai Khodabhai Valand
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[2]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[2]	Khodabhai was out of town and spoke to him over phone. He confirmed the surgery and he did not pay except for pre-op eye drops and some medicines post-op.
Details of the beneficiary[3]	Kantibhai Limbabhai Mayavanshi
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[3]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[3]	Limabhai is weak and wants to stop chemotherapy. We spoke at length about the disease itself and shared stories and tips that will help her with her post chemo weakness/nauseousness etc. There is some hope left since she knows how expensive it is and it is less stressful to do chemo for free or little money.
Details of the beneficiary[4]	Zarinaben Mahebubsa Diwan
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[4]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[4]	Mahebubsa confirmed she was getting meals and this is her first child so it was some load off when the hospital had such facilities, more than she had ever experienced. She is currently trying to enjoy her motherhood and gather her energy and recover.
Details of the beneficiary[5]	Rasmikaben Dasrathbhai Patel

Verification Visit status of beneficiary[5]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[5]	Dasrathbhai was not at home and her mother in law confirmed she was getting food and is almost sure they did not have to pay for it separately. Confirmed on call later that it was provided as mentioned in the DO.
Details of the beneficiary[6]	Daxaben Vishnubhai Thakor
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[6]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[6]	Pregnancy within a year of marriage, weakness, barely any income, the family thought they would lose her in this process of childbirth. The blood transfusion saved her life or that's what they were told and it was taken care of by the hospital.
Details of the beneficiary[7]	Varshaben Nareshbhai Harijan
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[7]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[7]	They were not completely aware about the procedures but they know the cost was overall subsidised and the mother and child are healthy right now.
Details of the beneficiary[8]	Rameshbhai Thakor
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[8]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[8]	Ramesh has been undergoing radiation for a while now and has confirmed that the costs vary. They are usually subsidised and sometimes free of cost. Though it is painful, he does thank people for keeping him going and infusing hope.
Details of the beneficiary[9]	Jasodaben Arvindbhai Thakor
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[9]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[9]	Arvindbhai's health is declining but is regular with his appointments and confirmed the costs are taken care of and he does not pay money for some sessions.
Details of the beneficiary[10]	Saurabhkumar VinubhaiThakor
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[10]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[10]	Vinubhai confirmed he was getting food when he was admitted in the hospital. He could not recollect what it was for that he got admitted and the family mentioned he kept getting sick and do not completely know but he is getting better now.
Details of the beneficiary[11]	Male Child of Snehalben Talpada
Verification Visit status of beneficiary[11]	Success
Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[11]	Snehal was eally worried watching all the tubes on her child but she was explained this would not cost her extra and this will help her baby incubate and get healthier. The child is now a year + old and Snehal is grateful.
