Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[2]	Om is 16 years, SSC passed out. He was diagnosed with ptosis in both eyes and was advised for a surgery. He was further admitted and operated at K B H Bachooali Charitable Ophthalmic & ENT Hospital in April 2016. They confirmed that Ekam Foundation paid Rs.15000 directly to the hospital out of the total bill of 26000. The NGO staff had visited their home several times. His father Mr. Rajesh Dhonnar has recently joined a sales firm and was very thankful for the support provided by the NGO when he was jobless.
