Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[1]	This is a very big hostel. I met Somabhai who has been residing in the hostel for past 6 years and does not have to pay for anything. His native place is in Arlshwarya district. He is getting lunch and dinner. The meals are complete and nutritious; dal, rice, roti, vegetables, khammam and sweet dish like gulab jamun,ladoo etc are the most common menu items.

Additional remarks by the Relationship Manager on beneficiary[2]	I visited the home. He had gone to the market to buy material so I spoke to his wife Sulekha. He is physically handicapped with left leg polio. He takes orders to alter clothes or stitch new clothes and works from home on the new sewing machine. he received it in Dec and did not pay anything for it. He had to go toe the BPA office to receive it. I have taken photo of Arun brand sewing machine.
